**Legal Technologies Librarian** - This position would work within LAI and in turn the library acting as the subject matter expert for emerging legal technology, law firm technology, and legal technology initiatives. Other duties include teaching a required first-year legal research course, contributing to the LAI curricular and non-curricular offerings, and offering significant guidance and input into the development and growth of the new department. - Experience teaching legal research or other law-based courses;
- Experience using library-relevant technology applications, including ALMA and SpringShare products;
- Familiarity with WordPress, web design, and consideration of user experience (UX).
